

Panna Tiger Reserve opened for tourists

BHOPAL: Panna Tiger Reserve in MP was Thursday opened for tourists, two days after four armed dacoits were flushed out from it, officials said. "Four armed men were noticed in the reserve on Tuesday after which the place was closed. The miscreants were flushed out from the area in the night," Reserve Field Director R S Murthy said. He denied reports that tourists were frightened to visit the reserve. "Right now I do not have figures of the tourists who have visited after Tuesday's incident but the tourist influx is normal," Murthy said.
